June is Elder Abuse Awareness Month

Elder financial abuse can happen to anyone and often goes unnoticed until significant damage has been done. This month, take time to learn the warning signs and ways to help protect yourself and your loved ones from financial exploitation.

4 Warning Signs of Financial Exploitation



Unusual Account Activity

Watch for unexpected withdrawals, transfers, purchases, or changes to account information that don't align with normal financial habits.



Pressure to Act Quickly

Be cautious of urgency tactics that push you to make financial decisions before you have time to think or verify information.



Sudden Changes to Financial Documents

Watch for unexpected changes to beneficiaries, powers of attorney, wills, or account ownership that seem out of character.



Isolation from Family or Trusted Advisors

Someone seeking financial control may discourage contact with family members, friends, or trusted professionals who could recognize suspicious activity.

If something doesn't seem right, trust your instincts. Reporting concerns early can help prevent further financial harm and protect those most vulnerable to exploitation.
